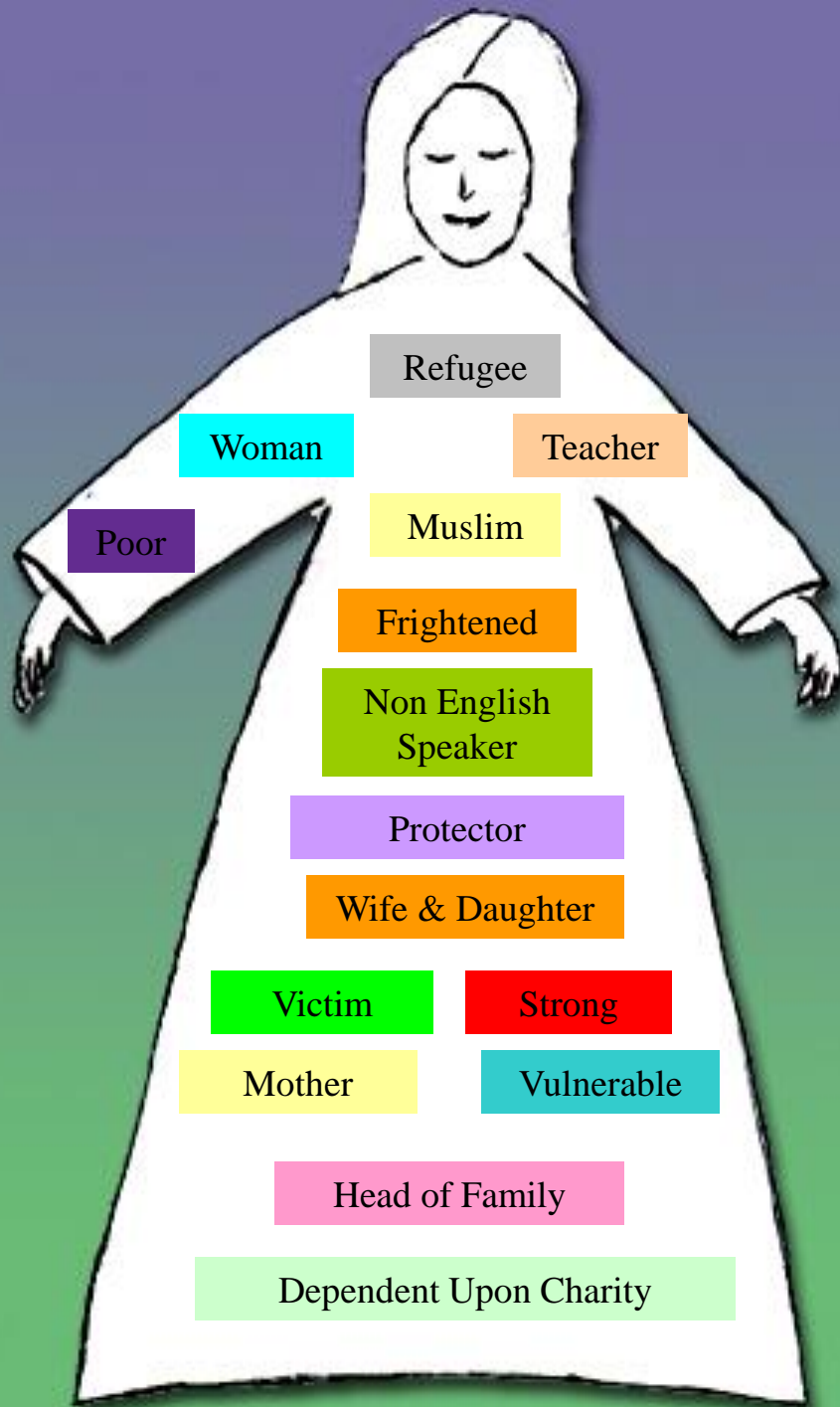
What is social identity?

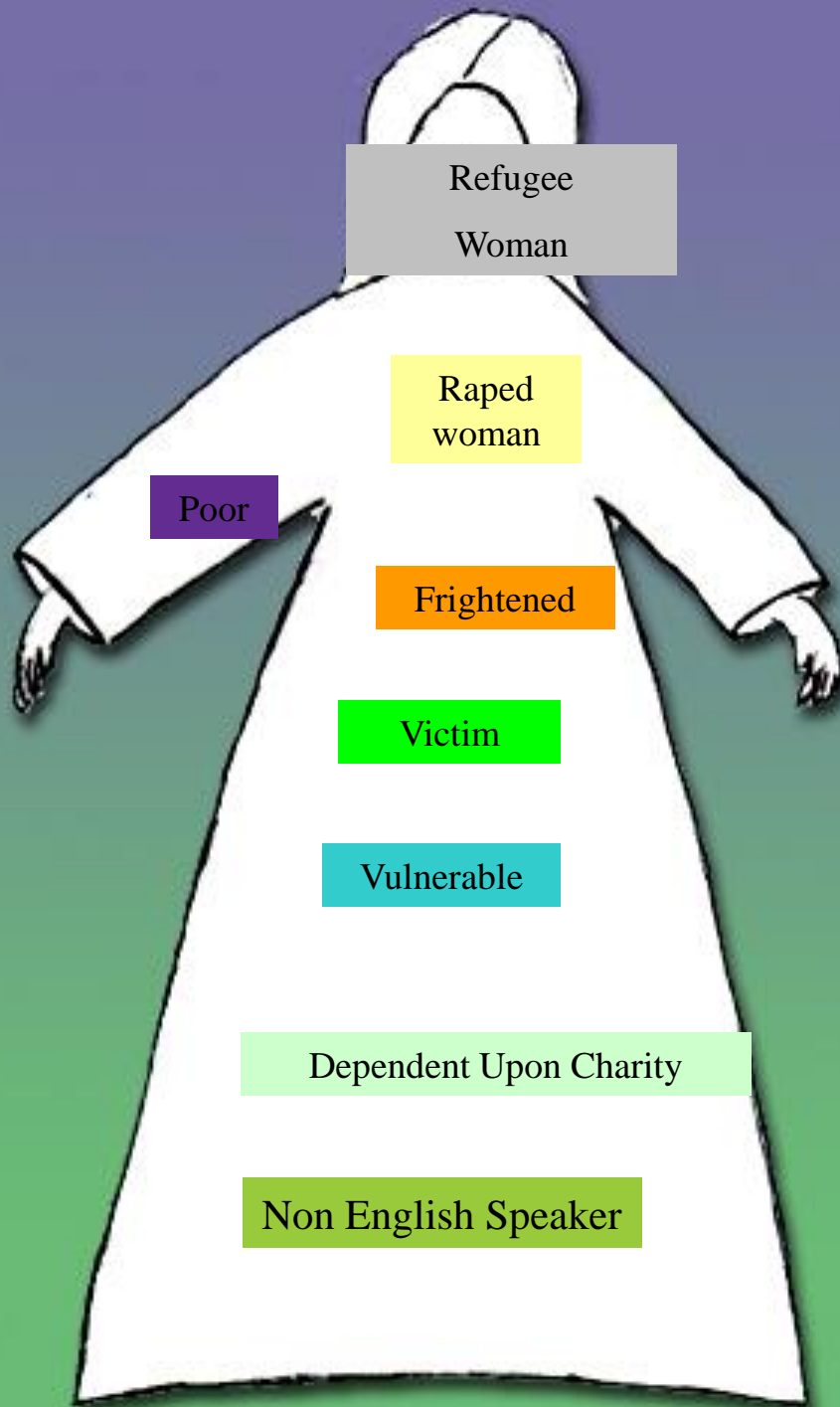

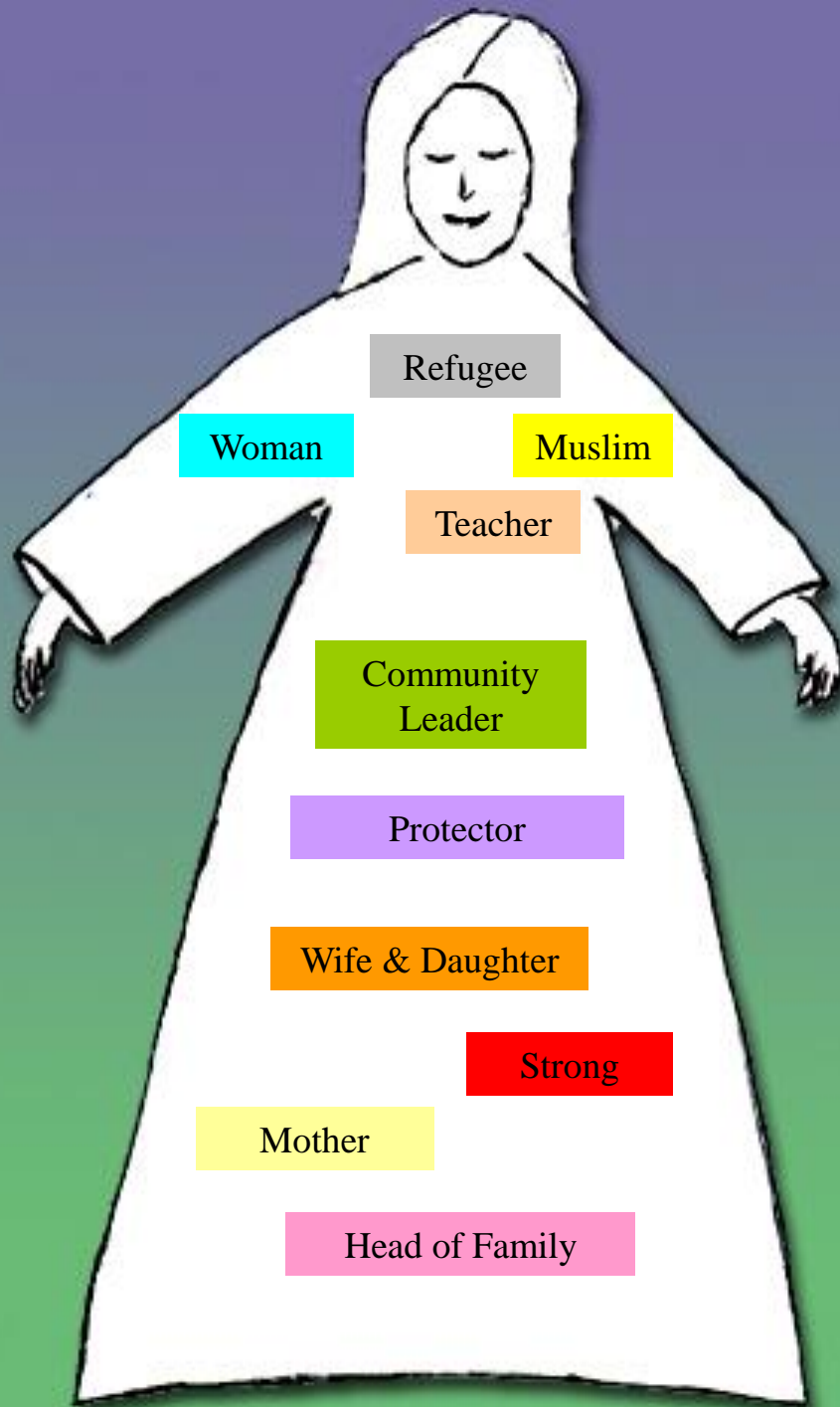
